




Alphabet Books

An alphabet book that explores self-esteem. (CAR)




[The Hullabaloo ABC](#) by Beverly Cleary

From Alligator's apples to Zebra's zucchini, a multitude of alphabetical animals and foods celebrate Thanksgiving with a grand feast. (DRA)







Each letter of the alphabet is illustrated by a word which applies to pictured guinea pigs. (DUK)






An alphabetical tour of the world of fruits and vegetables, from apricot and artichoke to yam and zucchini. (EHL)


[The Absolutely Awful Alphabet](#) by Mordicai Gerstein

An alliterative alphabet book presents mean and monstrous letters, from A (an awfully arrogant amphibian) to Z (a zig-zagging zoological zany). (GER)




[The Accidental Zucchini: An Unexpected Alphabet](#) by Max Grover

Introduces a bear for each letter of the alphabet and describes its special qualities in rhyme. (HAG)




[Charlie's ABC](#) by Nona Hatay

Photographs illustrate some of the common things in the life of a young child, from A (alphabet) to Z (zipper). (HAT)




[Ogres! Ogres! Ogres!: A Feasting Frenzy from A to Z](#) by Nicholas Heller

The letters of the alphabet are represented by an assortment of ogres devouring all sorts of foods. (HEL)




[26 Letters and 99 Cents](#) by Tana Hoban

Puddle teaches his friend Otto the letters of the alphabet so that Otto can write his name. (HOB)




[Alfie's ABC](#) by Shirley Hughes

An alphabet book using Alfie and his sister Annie Rose to illustrate the letters from A to Z. (HUG)




[ABC Pop!](#) by Rachel Isadora

Each letter of the alphabet is represented by illustrations in a pop art style. (ISA)




[On Your Toes: A Ballet ABC](#) by Rachel Isadora

Each letter of the alphabet is represented by an illustration of a ballet-related word. (ISA)





Alliterative text and pictures present adventures of animals from A to Z. (KEL)





A child buys presents from A to Z in the shops along Market Street. (LOB)




[Achoo! Bang! Crash!: The Noisy Alphabet](#) by Ross MacDonald

Words about sound and noise illustrate the letters of the alphabet. (MAC)




[Alphabatics](#) by Suse MacDonald


[Chicka Chicka Boom Boom](#) by Bill Martin

An alphabet rhyme/chant that relates what happens when the whole alphabet tries to climb a coconut tree. (MAR)




[Annie, Bea, and Chi Chi Dolores](#) by Donna Maurer

Illustrates the alphabet with animals and objects both large and small. (MCD)




[Museum ABC](#) by Metropolitan Museum of Art


[Pignic: An Alphabet Book in Rhyme](#) by Anne Miranda

An alphabet book featuring rhyming text and all sorts of animals. (RHY)




[ABC T-Rex](#) by Bernard Most


[The Furry Alphabet Book](#) by Jerry Pallotta

While showing her grandfather all the things, from A to Z, that she has brought with her to spend the night, a little girl suddenly realizes that she forgot one important item. (PAU)




[Alphabeep](#) by Debora Pearson

Describes a vehicle or street sign for every letter of the alphabet from Ambulance to Zamboni. (PEA)




[Miss Hindy's Cats](#) by Helena Pittman

Elegant paintings illustrate each letter of the alphabet. (SIM)




[Miss Bindergarten Gets Ready for Kindergarten](#) by Joseph Slate


[E is for Empire](#) by Ann Burg

Brief rhymes for each letter of the alphabet, accompanied by longer explanatory text, present features of the Empire State. (J917.47 BUR)




[The Butterfly Alphabet Book](#) by Brian Cassie

Presents alphabetically arranged entries on stars, galaxies, and constellations, based on observations of the sky at night and illustrated with astrophotographs for each entry. (J520 FAR)
