Hanel, Rachael. **The Japanese American Internment: An Interactive History Adventure**

This book describes the events surrounding the internment of Japanese Americans in relocation centers during World War II. The reader's choices reveal the historical details from the perspective of Japanese internees and Caucasians.

Lassiuer, Allison. **The Dust Bowl: An Interactive History Adventure**

In this adventure, the reader's choices reveal the historical details from the perspectives of a farmer, a migrant worker, and a government photographer in America's Dust Bowl.

Lassiuer, Allison. **The Wild West: An Interactive History Adventure**

The reader's choices reveal the historical details from the perspective of an outlaw, a lawman, and a fortune-seeker in Deadwood, Dakota Territory during the age of the Wild West.

Leavitt, Aime Jane. **The Battle of the Alamo: An Interactive History Adventure**

In a book where the outcomes and experiences are based upon real people and true events, the reader gets to choose between becoming a Mexican soldier or a Texan rebel during the siege of the Alamo.

Raum, Elizabeth. **World War II: An Interactive History Adventure**

This adventure describes the events of World War II and explains the significance of the war today. The reader's choices reveal the historical details from the perspective of a member of the Dutch resistance, a Canadian soldier, and an American soldier.

Temple, Bob. **The Golden Age of Pirates: An Interactive History Adventure**

Your choices reveal the historical details from the perspective of a pirate, a navy sailor, and a merchant ship crewmember.

Temple, Bob. **The Titanic: An Interactive History Adventure**

This book describes the sinking of the ship Titanic in 1912. Your choices reveal the historical details from the perspective of a first-class passenger, a third-class passenger, and a crewmember.



## **You Choose Books: Warriors** (*J You*)

Doeden, Matt. **Life as a Ninja: An Interactive History Adventure**

Your choices reveal historical details from the perspectives of a ninja taking part in the siege of Sawayama Castle, fighting the army of Oda Nobunaga, and serving as a member of the Band of Iga in feudal Japan.

Hanel, Rachael. **Life as a Knight: An Interactive History Adventure**

The reader's choices reveal historical details from the perspectives of a French knight during the Crusades, an English knight during the Hundred Years' War, and a German knight during the Peasants' War.

## **Graphic Novels**

Shiga, Jason. **Meanwhile**

In this choose-your-own adventure graphic novel, a boy stumbles on the laboratory of a mad scientist who asks him to choose between testing a mind-reading device, a time machine, and a doomsday machine. (*J Meanwhile*)

Schweizer, Chris. **Tricky Coyote Tales**

Coyote seeks food and fun in the canyons and hills and you must help him make choices as he encounters many other creatures, some friendly and some dangerous. (*J Tricky*)

## **Non-Fiction**

Prap, Lila. **Once Upon--1001 Stories**
