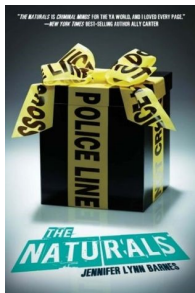

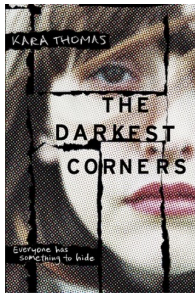


### The Naturals by Jennifer Lynn Barnes

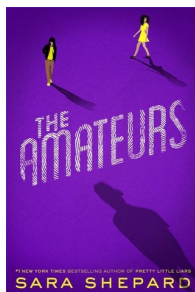


### The Darkest Corners by Kara Thomas

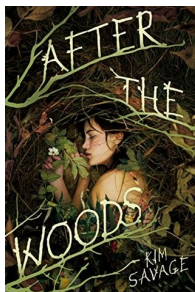


### The Amateurs by Sara Shepard

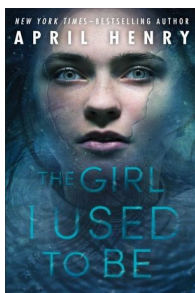


### After the Woods by Kim Savage
