




[The Book of Three](#) by Lloyd Alexander (*J ALE*)

Taran, Assistant Pig-Keeper to a famous oracular sow, sets out on a hazardous mission to save Prydain from the forces of evil.




[The Iron Trial](#) by Holly Black (*J BLA*)


[Artemis Fowl](#) by Eion Colfer (*J COL*)


[Spiderwick Chronicles: The Field Guide](#) by Tony DiTerlizzi (*J SPI*)


[Fablehaven](#) by Brandon Mull (*J MUL*)
