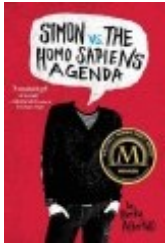

A gender-fluid teenager who struggles with identity creates a blog on the topic that goes viral, and faces ridicule at the hands of fellow students.

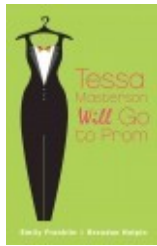

High school junior Leila's Persian heritage already makes her feel different from her classmates at Armstead Academy, and if word got out that she liked girls life would be twice as hard.

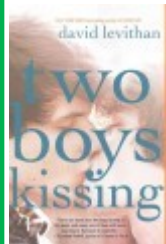

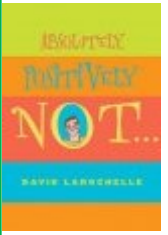
### Ash by Malinda Lo

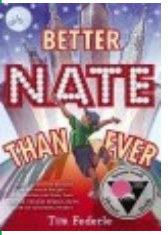
### Absolutely, Positively Not... by David LaRochele

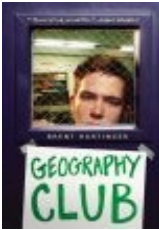

A group of gay and lesbian teenagers find mutual support when they form the "Geography Club" at their high school.

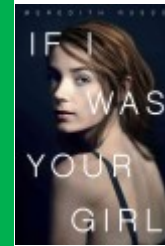

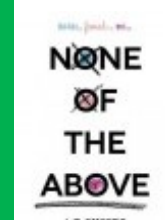
