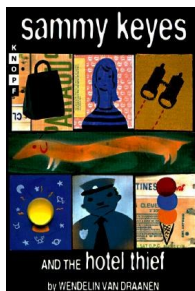

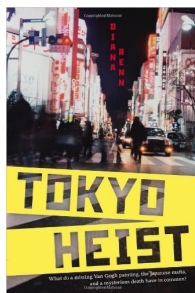


Sammy Keyes and the Hotel Thief by Wendelin Van Draanen

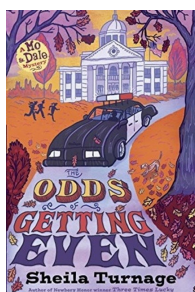


Tokyo Heist by Diana Renn

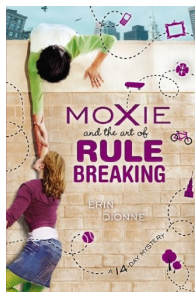


The Odds of Getting Even by Sheila Turnage
