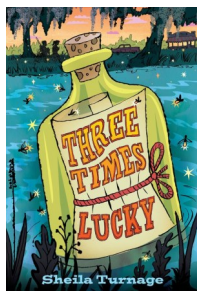

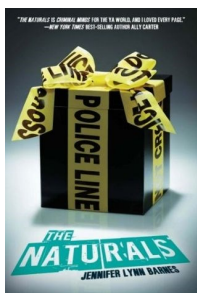


Three Times Lucky by Sheila Turnage

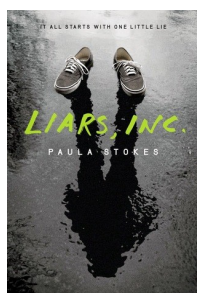


A Pocketful of Eyes by Lili Wilkinson
