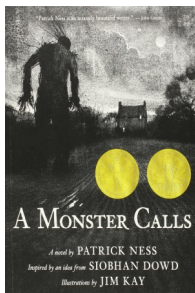


Second Chance Summer by Morgan Matson

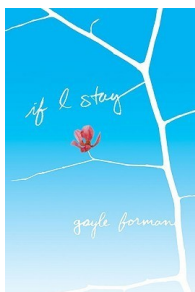


A Monster Calls by Patrick Ness

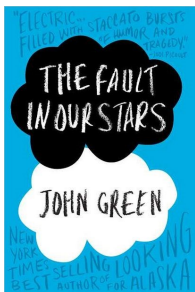


If I Stay by Gayle Forman
