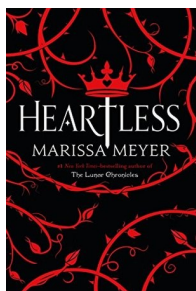

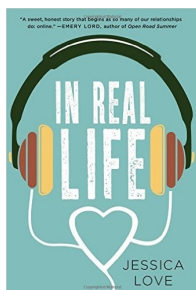


Exit, Pursued By A Bear by E. K. Johnston

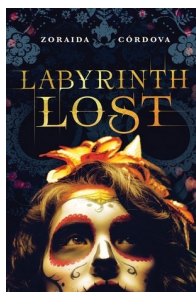


In Real Life by Jessica Love

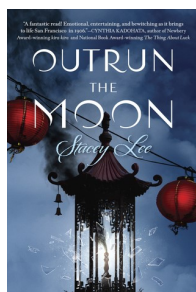


Labyrinth Lost by Zoraida Cordova
