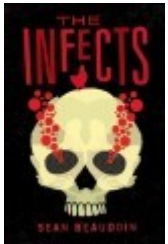

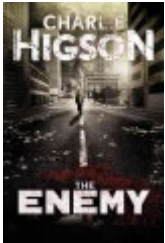

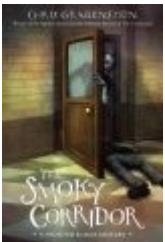


The Smoky Corridor by Chris Grabenstein

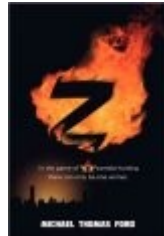

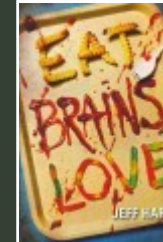


Ashes by Ilsa J. Bick
